As we gather, it is a good idea to review protocols that we need to adopt to ensure everyone's safety.

- First and most importantly: if you are feeling sick or under the weather, please stay home.
- Please refrain from physical contact such as handshaking, hugging, etc.
- Please use the handsanitizer as you enter and exit the sanctuary. The handsanitizer is located just inside the door on your right.
- Please wear a mask that covers both your nose and mouth during the service.
- Please seat six feet apart (in family units) from another person.
- Church windows will be cracked open to let air circulate. We will turn up the heat to help keep the temperature comfort, but it would be a good idea to wear a sweater or coat.
- If you are wearing a mask, please sing at a moderate volume.
- To limit time exposure, we will continue to only read a Psalm or Reading and the Gospel. Linda will attempt to limit the Message and length of songs.
- Linda will wear a face shield, in lieu of a mask, and remain on the altar during service.
- Contact tracing a list of those in attendance will be gathered each Sunday. If you should test postitive for COVID-19 during the week, please contact Linda Morin at (734) 657-7444 and we will in turn contact all those in attendance. All names will be anonymous.
- Bathroom please follow the procedures listed on the bathroom doors.
